WEEK 1 - NATURE

CAMPING ADVENTURE

Grab your flashlights; we're going on a bear hunt! Let's light the fire, settle in and learn all about animals in the forest as we embark on a camping trip filled with adventure. Sing campfire songs, learn about raccoons, chipmunks and bears, sleep in a tent and use our compass and flashlight to find our way from the tent to the campfire! This on-site field trip will finish up with roasting marshmallows around the "campfire".

THE FIVE SENSES

Learn about the Five Senses in this interactive program that uses all five! Children use their senses to learn all about the world around them. Touch something soft, taste something sour, smell something fragrant, listen to a quiet noise and look inside to find hidden objects in our special sensory boxes of all sizes. Our program finale allows students to interact with two of our gentle service dogs who help those whose five senses are limited.

MOBILE MARINE LAB

Mobile Marine Lab is a tide pool on wheels. Our Marine biologists bring a variety of marine life to your location. Students will hold a live sea star, feed a sea urchin, let a hermit crab tickle their hand, and maybe even pet a fish! Animals are carefully collected from local tide pools for display in our touch tanks. After your event, the animals will be returned to the tide pools where they were taken.

DINO DIG

Get your shovels and picks, let's get ready to dig! At this on-site field trip, Jr. paleontologists will dig for dinosaur bones using shovels, picks, magnifying glasses and brushes. We will locate and put together the bones of the following Dinosaurs; the Triceratops, the Brontosaurus or the Tyrannosaurus rex. Our trained instructor will lead the children through this exciting exploration from beginning to end.

SCIENCE AND SPACE

Coming in for a landing! Our Astronaut Instructor will lead us through a hands-on interplanetary science adventure in Space and Astronomy. Bring your spacesuit and come ready to explore. Younger students explore color science while older student dig deeper into experimenting with gravity. Class ends with a 5-minute stargazing laser show that will amaze your senses!
